ABOUT THE COURSE

In this course, we will demonstrate proficiency in the conceptual development of content in two-dimensional media, to create self-directed or collaborative 2-D artwork suitable for inclusion in a portfolio. Through the critique process, students evaluate and respond to their own work and that of their peers. Through a focused investigation of traditional techniques, historical and cultural models, and individual expressive goals, students begin to develop a personal art style. This course incorporates hands-on activities and consumption of art materials

ONLINE ACCESS

Students will be accessing Teams on a regular basis to participate in class, check for instructions, and submit classwork.
